## Developing the Creative Imagination

Imagination is the creative spark within us. It is that God faculty which we use in finding our way back to God. You can develop this through the creative tech-

niques described in the ECK<sup>2</sup> books.

When we come into this world, we are given the ability to maintain a status quo; in other words, to get us from birth to death with the usual life problems and situations. But if we want to step on the spiritual path and begin making our way back to God, we have to work for it. The way we work for it is by using our

imaginative faculty to start creating the world as we would have it.

Everything that we have today—from our preference in clothing to our position in the family where we happened to reincarnate—has actually been a result of our attitudes as they have formed over the centuries. So what we want to do is spiritualize our consciousness today. And we do it by working with the creative imagination.

We know we can shape our future because the future is unformed. You can make it what you want. But first you have to be able to visualize what you want very clearly. Unfortunately, most people look for materialistic goals such as money, health, wealth, and companionship. But as I’ve mentioned: Jesus said, “Seek ye first the Kingdom of God . . . and all these things shall be added unto you.” Make sure your goal is worth the trouble.

To develop your creative imagination, work with the Spiritual Exercises of ECK. You can experiment with the following technique:

First choose something you want in your life or pick a problem that needs to be dealt with. Then set clear goals.

Second, ask yourself the following questions. Your goals must pass four tests: (1) Are they specific? (2) Are they realistic? (3) Can the results be verified? and (4) Do they give a date for completion?

## A New Point of View

Last year, I developed a health problem that made it impossible for me to work. For the first time in forty-seven years, I had no way of supporting myself. I had to apply for a disability pension to survive.

This left me in a state of depression. At sixty-three, I still had several years until my full pension would start. I needed help.

As a member of Eckankar, when faced with difficult situations, I have learned to ask the Mahanta,<sup>3</sup> the Inner Master, for guidance. So each day during my daily spiritual exercise, I asked for help.

Soon, answers began to come through dreams or inner nudges. I used a journal to make notes of the insights I received from the ECK and the Inner Master.

As I contemplated this divine guidance, the depression gradually lifted. I began to accept that it was time for me to start a new life as a retiree.

Without employment, my income would be much smaller. I wondered if it was possible for me to survive under this new financial situation. In reply to my silent question, inwardly I heard the Mahanta say only one word: “Frugality.”

He was telling me I could do it. But I would have to economize in every area of my life.

I began to practice this right away and did

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everything I could to lower my expenditures. I took advantage of special offers in the grocery stores, reduced my travel plans, and even decided to lose weight to shrink my food and clothing costs.

As my expenses diminished, I found I had a lot more money to spend. Things were looking up!

On my sixty-fourth birthday, I received a letter from the Social Security office with the details of my disability pension. When I read the letter, my heart jumped. I couldn't believe my eyes! Due to my work overseas, my pension was much higher than I had expected. In addition, I was also entitled to a pension from the navy.

With my new economical lifestyle, the two pensions gave me more than enough money to live comfortably. I thanked the Mahanta for this amazing gift.

A month later, I attended a dance at an ECK seminar. As I listened to the music, I was thinking about what I had gone through. Just then, the musicians began playing a well-known song with these words: “Will you still need me, will you still feed me, when I'm sixty-four?”

It was a confirmation from Divine Spirit, reminding me that when I do my part, the ECK and the Mahanta will always be there to help and guide me through life.

It was nine months to the day since I had first applied for my disability pension. I mentioned this to a friend. She said, “That's the same time it takes to give birth!”

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

## Ask a Modern Prophet about Creating Your Future

*I am confused about detachment and how it works in terms of striving for anything, or if we even should strive. Should a person try to get ahead or be successful in worldly terms, or should he just put his efforts into spiritual unfoldment (aside from supporting himself and dependents if he has them)? Is wanting, striving, and desiring just another negative trap?*

The wrong definition for detachment is “don’t get involved in life.” In Eckankar, we are detached, but we are also great lovers of life. Can it be any other way for a Co-worker with God?

The path of Eckankar is only to enhance our spiritual growth. How does this unfoldment come about? Through daily duties. Yes, it is all right to set goals in business. We can set goals, work to accomplish them, and still be working in the arena of detachment. Detachment means that if our plans don’t work out as we think they should, life won’t crush us.

The path of ECK ought to bring a zest for life. Each activity contains within it the seed of a spiritual lesson. We do not make spiritual progress by doing as little as possible in life. The individual must make an honest evaluation of his talents, interests, and training to decide what goals he wishes to strive for.

Every time he sets out to win small goals, he is aware in Soul consciousness that their only purpose is to give instruction in becoming a citizen of the spiritual hierarchy.

We must first give to life if we expect life to give anything in return. This is the divine law. Life presents a whole series of opportunities. These let us tap into the God Force for aid. This is achieved through the regular practice of the Spiritual Exercises of ECK.
